Admission to Master of Physiotherapy(MPT) 2025-26

Notification

Ref: G.O(Rt) No.1954/2025/H&FWD, dated Thiruvananthapuram 15.7.2025

1. Introduction

Applications are invited for admission to MPT course for the Academic year 2025-26 as per the prospectus approved vide G.O(Rt) No. 1954/2025/H&FWD, dated Tvpm 15.7.2025. The prospectus is published in the website www.lbscentre.kerala.gov.in. Applications can be submitted online to the Director, LBS Centre for Science and Technology through the website www.lbscentre.kerala.gov.in from 12th August 2025 to 30th August 2025.

2. Eligibility for admission

a. MPT course offers 6 specialisations (5 seats each).

1. Master of Physiotherapy in Cardio Respiratory
2. Master of Physiotherapy in Musculo Skeletal and Sports
3. Master of Physiotherapy in Neurology
4. Master of Physiotherapy in Pediatrics
5. Master of Physiotherapy in Community Health and Geriatrics
6. Master of Physiotherapy in Obstetrics and Gynecology

b. ACADEMIC ELIGIBILITY

Candidates, who have passed the BPT examination Degree from any of the Universities in Kerala or from any other University recognized by Kerala University of Health Sciences (hereafter KUHS), with 50% marks(aggregate of all the years of University examinations of the course) through full time regular mode of study. The candidate shall have obtained permanent registration in the respective state council wherever applicable.

Students who are undergoing internship are eligible to apply; however, they must have qualified at the time of admission.

3. Duration of the Course

The duration of the courses is 2 years. The maximum permitted period for completion of the courses shall be 4 years.

4. Application Fee

The application fee is given below. A candidate who does not belong to SC/ST communities will be treated as 'General' candidate for the collection of application fee.

General Candidates : ₹ 1200/-

SC/ST Candidates : ₹ 600/-

5. Application Submission

Applications for admission to the course must be submitted online through the website www.lbscentre.kerala.gov.in. The prospectus is also available for download from the same website.

There are various stages for submission of application. Applicants have to complete all the stages as per the prescribed time schedule.

6. Registration and Remittance of Application Fee

Candidates will have to visit the web site www.lbscentre.kerala.gov.in and click on the link 'Various Allotments' and click the link 'Admission to MPT course 2025'. The following steps are to be completed for submitting an application.

a. Registration

All the basic information, required in the application is to be filled in at this step. Candidate should click the button "New Registration". The personal details of the candidates have to be filled in the page thus obtained. It is obligatory that the candidate should fill all the items in the registration stage. Category of the candidate (Whether SC/ST or General) needs to be specified here. As per the category, the application fee payable will be displayed and the candidate can proceed to the next step.

b. Fee payment

The application fee can be remitted either by online or by using challan (generated online at the time of registration) at any one of the branches of Federal Bank from **12.8.2025 to 30.8.2025** using the application number obtained after registration. For those who remit the application fee online, can proceed with subsequent stage of application submission. Those who remit application fee by way of challan can continue by logging into the website after 24 hours and entering the fee payment details.

Applicants shall keep their application number, password and registration id strictly confidential.

c. Filling in Personal and Academic Details and Uploading Documents

Candidates have to fill in all the items in the application entry stage including academic data. The candidates should upload all the certificates and documents in support of various claims (to prove age, reservation and marks) made in the application. Scanned copies of the photograph, signature, and certificates to be uploaded must conform to the specified dimensions and file size (Refer Annexure VIII in the prospectus).

d. Final Confirmation

Do the FINAL SUBMISSION only after making sure that the application is complete and correct in all respects. No changes will be permitted after the final confirmation. Applications of candidates who have not made final confirmation will be considered incomplete and will not be considered under any circumstances.

7. Last Date of Submission of Application. The last date for submission of application is 1.9.2025. Applicants need not send a hard copy of the application to the LBS Centre, Thiruvananthapuram.

8. Preparation of Ranklist

Ranklist will be prepared based on the aggregate marks obtained in the qualifying examination. Refer clause 10 in the prospectus.

9. Allotment to the course

The allotment process will be carried out by the Director, LBS Centre for Science and Technology, in accordance with the prospectus approved by the Government and within the prescribed schedule. Allotment will be based on the candidate's rank.
